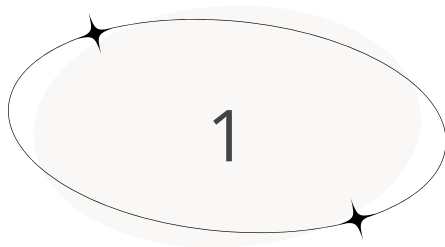

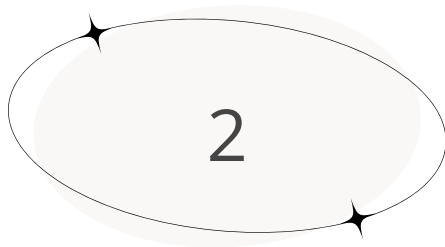

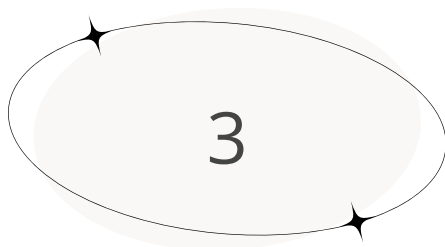
SELF-ASSESSMENT

Ask yourself what your strengths, interests, passions, and values are. Reflect on your skills and what truly makes you happy.



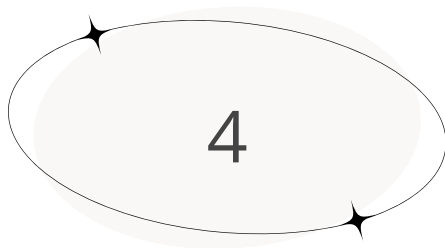
RESEARCH AND EXPLORE

Dive deep into your desired field, industry, or job role. Gather information, network, and attend relevant events.



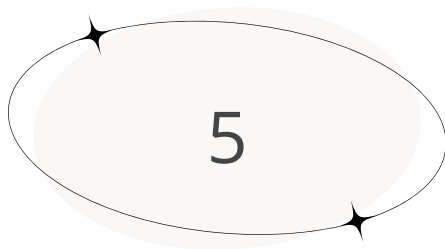
PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
